

Helpful Accessory – An Ounce of Prevention

In the parking lot at the last meeting a member noticed and asked about the extra wire on my bonnet latch. I told him about the Remote Bonnet Release that attaches to the lever

and exits into the left side front wheel well. If the original release cable should break, this cable serves as an emergency release. It also comes in handy as an alternative if you don't want to reach into the car to pull the original release handle.

The instructions call for drilling a hole in the inner fender wall but I didn't find that to be necessary. I simply routed it through the grommet for the headlight wiring. That leaves it only a bit harder to reach but it's better than the alternatives should the original release cable break.
