

MGS ON POSTAGE STAMPS

Stamps have been often called miniature "Works of Art", and since we all think our MGs equally merit that description too, what better collection could there be than of MGs on postage stamps. Expanding your interest past just MGs is a much more challenging task, literally hundreds of British cars have been featured on stamps and thousands of cars in general. While the primary interest is in the cars, some of the countries from which the stamps are issued are intriguing too, some being just atolls that probably never saw an MG. Many of the countries that are prolific in the production of stamps are those that may have little or no other income, so very often, far more stamps go to collectors than are actually used for ordinary mailing purposes. The Caribbean islands Grenadines of St Vincent and the islands of St Kitts and Nevis at least have tourism but the Pacific island of Tuvalu supports itself largely by the sale of stamps and more recently selling web domain names that have the cherished dot tv suffix. About 1% the size of Washington DC, it has the unenviable reputation of being the first nation that will disappear should sea levels rise above its 17 ft (5m) maximum elevation. Seen here are on the top row are MG types: M, K3, TC and MGA. At left is an MGB-GT.

Below: from Grenada is another K3, a TA from the Indian Ocean islands of Comoros and another from the English Channel British Crown Dependency of the "Bailiwick of Guernsey" and a TF from the land locked enclave of South Africa, the Kingdom of Lesotho.

Bottom Row: An MGB stamp issued by the West African Republic of Liberia, a Midget from the former USSR of Turkmenistan, a TF from Somalia, and an MGA with Mickey and Minnie Mouse from the Caribbean island of Redonda.
